* **Late starts:** School will start approximately 1.5 hours late on 4 days during the school year to give teachers time to review the results of important student testing data and collaborate on strategies to improve student learning in a timely manner. School ending time on late start days will be the same; the school day will NOT be extended. Please make child care/transportation arrangements early, because there won't be supervision for students until mid-morning. Public school buses WILL run on those days; bus hours will be adjusted according to the late start times. Specific late start information will be sent home in the fall and made available on BPS websites after school has begun and bus routes are set.

Bismarck Public School District's Calendar Process:

A committee of teachers, parents and school administrators begin work on the school calendar in October. Draft(s) are presented to the Superintendent and School Board in November. The board typically asks the administration to gather feedback from teachers and parents/guardians regarding the calendar draft(s). The board approves the final calendar in December for the coming school year. The final calendar is sent home in January and again in August. It is also located on the district website at www.bismarckschools.org under the Calendars link on the left. This timeframe gives patrons sufficient time to make day care, vacation, and other arrangements.

N.D. law regarding SCHOOL HOLIDAYS:

According to state law in North Dakota, school may not be in session:

1. Any Sunday
2. New Year's Day, the first day of January
3. Good Friday, the Friday preceding Easter Sunday
4. Memorial Day, the last Monday in May
5. Fourth of July
6. Labor Day, the first Monday in September
7. Veteran's Day, the eleventh day of November
8. Thanksgiving Day, the fourth Thursday in November
9. Christmas Day, the 25th day of December
10. Any day declared to be a public holiday by the President of the United States or the governor of North Dakota.

NOTE: If a holiday falls on a Saturday, the district will observe the holiday on the preceding Friday. If the holiday falls on a Sunday, it will be observed the following Monday.

N.D. law regarding SCHOOL CALENDARS:

According to North Dakota state law, a school district shall provide for a school calendar of at least 182 days as of the 2011-2012 school year:

1. 175 days of instruction/student contact days
2. 3 holidays selected by the school board and district teachers (in Bismarck Public Schools, these have typically been Veteran's Day, Martin Luther King Day, and Good Friday)
3. 2 days for parent-teacher conferences
4. 2 days professional development days for teachers

NOTE: Beginning in 2010-2011, a school district may provide an optional professional development day through four, 2-hour early dismissal days.

NOTE: School districts must provide two unpaid days off in the school calendar for teachers to attend the NDEA Teachers Convention, usually in mid-October.
